OBJECT OF DESIRE The views, over the *entire* city. This place is tucked between floors 47 and 52 in a seemingly never-ending skyscraper, so it's ALL about what you can see through those spotless expanses of glass. The 164 rooms are positively gargantuan by Tokyo standards, but best of the bunch are the suites, each with a scoop-your-jaw-off-the-floor sweep over the glittering skyline. Decor is minimal, with crisp white linen and wooden partitions that you can slide around like Tetris tiles. The only traditional touch is the Japanese tub, big enough for you and a team of sumo wrestlers.

SEXIEST SPOT The rooftop, which has both an indoor and an outdoor bar, where you can sit and knock back every sake known to man (although we recommend you don't).

WORTH GETTING OUT OF BED FOR

Clay pot-baked chicken and lobster poached with wasabi at Andaz Tavern, which does a neat line in Euro-Japanese fusion food.

COOL OFF In the AO spa overlooking the Imperial Palace. Do some laps in the 20m swimming pool, chill out in the floating jet bath and zone out with an Oriental Healing massage.

ME HOTEL

Say *buenos dias* to the ME in Santa Eulalia, a chilled-out haven in the midst of all that sweaty madness. There are glorious seascapes, gleaming all-white suites and spot-on seafood. And, if you actually quite fancied checking out one of those wild pool parties, Nikki Beach is right next door.

SEXIEST SPOT The rooftop deck, for its practically deserted plunge pool, stupidly comfy sun loungers and dazzling panoramas of the sun sinking into the Med.

WORTH GETTING OUT OF BED FOR The Jet by ME package, which whisks you off to Ibiza via the hotel's swish private jet and includes daily treatments at the rooftop spa and your own dedicated 'aura manager' (trust us, you want one).

COOL OFF Hop onto the hotel's boat for the one-hour trip to Formentera, where you can tuck into salt-baked fish and homemade plum cake at the white-tented Juan y Andrea restaurant and splash around in the sparkliest turquoise water this side of Barbados. ▷
